Students enrolled in the Bachelor of Fine Arts or Bachelor of Visual Arts who are interested in applying to study in Prato in 2007 as part of their undergraduate degree program.

Please note:

The Semester in Prato program

- The Semester in Prato program is only applicable to students who will be in the 2nd year of their degree in 2007.
- The 8 week study period in Prato commences in September and concludes at the end of October 2007.
- The program involves 24 credit points of units and comprises:
 - major studio unit (12 cps)
 - a theory of art and design unit, TAD2130 *Concept & Creativity: the Development of Italian Art & Design* (6cps)
 - a drawing unit, DWG2782 *Visual Investigations* (6cps)

The Half Semester in Prato program

- The Half Semester in Prato program is applicable to students who will be in the 2nd or 3rd year of their degree in 2007.
- The 5 week study period in Prato commences in June and concludes in July 2007 (mid year break).
- The program involves 12 credit points of units and comprises:
 - a theory of art and design unit, TAD2130 *Concept & Creativity: the Development of Italian Art & Design* (6cps)
 - a drawing unit, DWG2782 *Visual Investigations* (6cps)
- The program includes approximately four days in Venice

Selection criteria

- Selection criteria for both programs include the following:
 - first-come-first-served
 - diversity of group (eg inclusion of students from different disciplines, different campuses)
 - academic record
 - the nature of the individual's studies i.e. major studio and personal study path and relevance of the Prato program to this

Program costs

- The program costs for 2007 are not yet available. The semester program cost (airfare & accommodation) for 2006 was \$5550.
- All credit plus average students enrolled in the Semester program in 2006 received a Monash Abroad grant of \$2000 (students enrolled in a 5 week program received \$1000)
- Students enrolled in the Semester program may also be eligible for an OS-HELP loan of up to \$5095. This will be added to your HECS or HELP debt and be subject to repayment terms as the rest of the debt. Only undergraduate, Commonwealth Supported students who are Australian citizens are eligible.
